Please note that you must submit an application, even if you have a sibling at the school. Thank you.

Punctuality & Attendance

We would like to remind you that the school takes punctuality and attendance very seriously.

Lateness: The gates open at 8.45 a.m. with children going into school at 8.55 a.m. Pupils are marked down as late if they arrive after 9.05 a.m. and absent for the morning if arriving after the register closes at 9.15 a.m. If a child is persistently late this may result in a penalty notice being issued.

It is the responsibility of the parent or carer to contact the school before 8.55 a.m., telling us about the absence and

Parking

Yesterday there was an incident on White Cottage Road where a Cage Green parent, who was parked on double yellow lines,

almost reversed into a child. It is unfortunate that, at the beginning of the New Year, we have to send this message out again. Please remember:

- No parking on single or double yellow lines
- No double parking
- No stopping, dropping or parking on the 'School Keep Clear' yellow zig zags
- No parking on corners or junctions especially near the school entrance
- Please do not block driveways

Fewer cars at the school entrance will help make it safer for you and your children.

Here's what you can do instead...

- **Park & Stride**
Consider walking part of the way to school by parking away from the school entrance and walking the last 5 or 10 minutes.
- **Car Sharing**
Consider sharing the school run. If you have to drive to school then get together with other parents who need to go by car and take it in turns to drive.
- **Walking Bus**
Organise a small group of parents to share the walking to school and take it in turns with other parents to do the school run.
