On Monday the Fire Service gave a safety talk to Years 1 to 6. Children were advised to make sure that they had smoke detectors in their homes; if they don't have them they can be fitted for free by the fire service. Children watched a short video that showed how quickly a fire can develop in a room and that all families need a fire escape plan in their homes. Children were advised to discuss this with their parents and make sure they had a plan for leaving their house safely when an alarm sounds. There was also advice about responsible use of the 999 service.
