Many children were surprised to discover games they play online and social media sites they go on are for 13 years of age and above. Perhaps the most surprising was finding out that the legal age to use Whatsapp is 16 years old. We would encourage

you as parents and carers to check the age restrictions of any internet app or site your child uses, as there are restrictions there to keep your children safe. The children were shown the CEOP website which they use in computing lessons and is a very good website aimed at staying safe online.
