On Thursday 29th March – the last day of term – the kitchen will serve fish and chips, rather than the advertised meal.



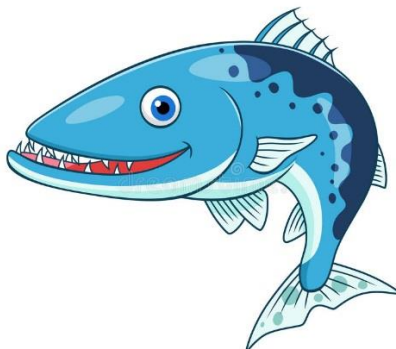
