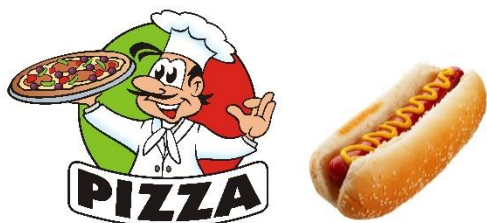
Best Class Attendance
