The Malling School at East Mallings’ Open Morning will be held on Friday 26<sup>th</sup> June between 9.30 a.m. and 12.30 p.m.

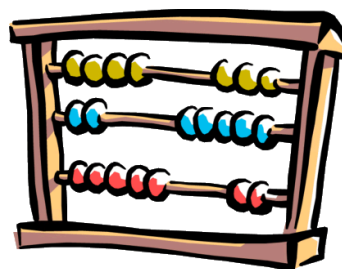
**RSPB Wildlife Fair**
