Young Persons Travel Pass - 2018 / 19

Bus Travel for Kent secondary school students

Standard cost £290 for the year

* discounts and half year passes are available *

Apply from 4th June and by 13th July to avoid disappointment.

Abuse it – lose it!

You are responsible for your own behaviour.

DO – look after your pass and have it with you for all travel; listen to the driver and follow their instructions; be respectful of all other passengers including your peers; wait to get on and off the bus sensibly; board the first available vehicle to avoid overcrowding and being late.

DO NOT – misbehave; move about the vehicle; be disrespectful; distract the driver or interfere with the vehicle equipment; throw objects; give your pass to someone else to use; put your feet on the seats; push other passengers as you attempt to board or leave the bus.
