**Medications**

Please be advised that if your child requires medications to be administered during the school day, you must bring it to the school office and complete a form enabling school staff to administer it on your behalf.

Please do not leave medications in your child's school bags, where other children may be able to get hold of it - and do not leave it with the class teacher or TA, as they do not have the relevant form for you to complete.

If your child suffers with asthma and requires medication for this during the school day, you need to provide the school with the medication which can be left in class full time (and does not need to be dropped off and collected each day). You MUST also complete and sign an asthma card before we can administer these medications.

Medicines which need to be taken less than four times a day should be administered at home, e.g., outside of school hours. Thank you.
